Terms & Regulations

Deposit and Payment

- A \$400 non-refundable deposit is due at the time of booking to hold reservation
- Payments on credit card to a maximum of \$2500. Tournament charges over and above may be invoiced and payable by cheque within 30 days of tournament date.

Liability

The event organizer and/or organization they represent shall be held liable for any damages not associated with normal wear and tear that may arise as a result of the actions of the event guests. Replacement value will be used as a guide to the amount payable for damages, as well as any lost revenue resulting from the damage.

Eaglepoint Golf Resort shall not be responsible for personal property of equipment brought to the site of the event except when management accepts responsibility for the storage and security of items delivered to the site.

Management must be contacted prior to the set-up of displays or signage to ensure that no damage arises as a result of the set-up

Health and Liquor Board Regulations

In accordance with Health and Liquor Board Regulations of British Columbia, all food and beverage shall be purchased from Eaglewood Restaurant & Bar. Staff are licensed under the Province of British Columbia's Serving it Right program. Staff members shall reserve the right to refuse service to any individual(s) who, in the opinion of the staff, have been served a sufficient number of drinks or has consumed alcohol off-premise or not sold to the individual by the operator.

*** No outside alcohol is permitted on the premises.**

Eaglepoint Golf Resort Reserves the right and will remove any person(s) from the course who are in breach of this regulation without a refund.

Inclement Weather

Tournament bookings shall be played as scheduled, rain or shine unless the Superintendent/ Management determines that the golf course is unplayable. In the event the golf course is deemed unplayable, we will work with you to find an alternative date, issue rain checks, or in extraordinary circumstances issue a refund.

Power Carts

The tournament organizer, company representative, or company whom signs the contract will take full responsibility for the actions of the people within their event and by signing the contract, they are taking full responsibility for any damages incurred to any power cart or operators, indemnifying Eaglepoint Golf Resort of any wrong doing.

Dress Code

We encourage guest to wear golf attire, proper footwear is a must.

General Rules

- Instructions from the Course Marshall must be strictly adhered to.
- Cart path signs must be obeyed at all times with no exceptions
- Maximum of two players per power cart
- maximum 4 players “foursome” per tee time, unless otherwise authorized by the golf shop

The group organizer is responsible for the conduct of all participants and it is the group organizer responsibility to inform the players of the rules and ensure that these are followed at all times.

Food & Beverage

Reservations are recommended for the restaurant and Lounge if no pre-planned food and beverage arrangements have been made in advance.

The number of guests for buffet packages **must be confirmed 5 days prior to your event date.**

Please advise us on any dietary restrictions/ gluten free meals required, as there is an additional cost.

The confirmed number of people to eat is the amount that will be billed.

Tournament Planning

Tee Times: Groups will start on Hole # 1 or #10 at 9 minute intervals

18 Hole Shotgun: Eaglepoint can accommodate a full shotgun (144 players) at either 8am or 1pm start times only. Arrangements for shotgun tournaments must be booked well in advance.

9 Hole Shotgun: Available after 3pm and are a great format for smaller groups to all be able to start and finish their round of golf at the same time.

9 Hole or 18 Hole Best Ball Scramble All golfers tee off with their own ball. The best ball is then picked after each shot and everyone picks their ball up and places it from the “best ball” location. This process is the same for each ball hit until the ball is putted out. The same format for each hole played. Score is counted using one stroke for each best ball. This format is great for beginners, as it alleviates the pressure of playing with better players.
